



PARENT/CARER CODE OF CONDUCT

RESPECT

- Remember that players play football for fun and enjoyment, accept mistakes as part of their learning and development.
- Do not use profane or threatening language to harass players, parents/carers, coaches, or officials.
- Always respect umpires and their decisions. Remember they are trying to do their best.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from junior football.
- Encourage your child to always play by the rules and display honourable on field actions.

INSPIRE

- Foster a positive attitude by helping your child work on improving skills and praising enthusiasm and displays of good sportsmanship.
- Celebrate good play from both teams and make our visitors welcome.
- Encourage honest effort and enjoyment in playing. Emphasise these factors as being as important as victory, so the result of the game is accepted with minimal disappointment.
- Use positive and motivating language when supporting your child and their team. Limit sideline feedback and advice.
- Support and encourage a team/club first mentality in your child.
- Assist RJFC to promote a positive attitude towards football including healthy moral, mental, and emotional development.

RESPONSIBILITY

- Support RJFC by contacting your coach, team manager or club president to offer your assistance. Investing in YOUR team and club will benefit not only the team but your child/family; look for opportunities to assist where you can and fulfil rostered duties.
- Report any behaviour by members, volunteers and visitors that may be deemed inappropriate and/or go against RJFC club policies to the president and integrity officer.
- Adhere to and reinforce a smoke, vape, drug & alcohol-free environment in accordance with the RJFC and WAFC Smoking and Alcohol Policy.
- Communicate with coaches, team managers and other parents/carers via means of email and/or other chat methods. The president and secretary must be included in any group communications via other means.
- Adhere to/support any disciplinary directives if there is a breach of RJFC or WAFC policy.
